

Chronology of the UNODC reconfiguration process

1. Major donors reduced to the minimum all cooperation with Bolivia (2006-2008)

2. Substantial reduction of UNODC budget and Operations (for programs and office)(Nov. 2008)

3. UNODC 2008 Coca Survey for Bolivia (increase in coca cultivation/cocaine production for a 3d consecutive year)

4. The Government of Bolivia expresses the will to maintain a solid the UNODC presence including a Representative (Jun. 2009)

4.1 The Bolivian government contacted the European Commission to facilitate the process and support

- i) Office Costs
- ii) Programme Expansion (May-Jun

5. UNODC expert mission from HQ to assess programme revive

6. Workshop to draft UNODC Bolivia Country Programme 2010-2015, which counted with all relevant local and international partners (Sept - Oct 2009)

6.1 The Workshops ended with a needs assessment document, which:

- i) was consulted with participating institutions (Oct)
- ii) send to UNODC HQ for fine-tuning (Nov) and
- iii) final draft submitted to GoB (Dec. 2009)

6.2 The final draft of UNODC Programme document ready by early March 2010

7. An advance presentation of UNODC BCP will take place during at UN-CND in Vienna (9 March 2010)

8. Formal presentation of UNODC BCP in Bolivia (24 March 2010)

9. President Evo Morales presents the re-launched UNODC Bolivia office

10. Preparation meeting with the donor community for the Round Table on the UNODC BCP (20 September 2010)

11. Round Table on the UNODC BCP to take place in Brussels, Belgium, sponsored by the European Union 13 October 2010
