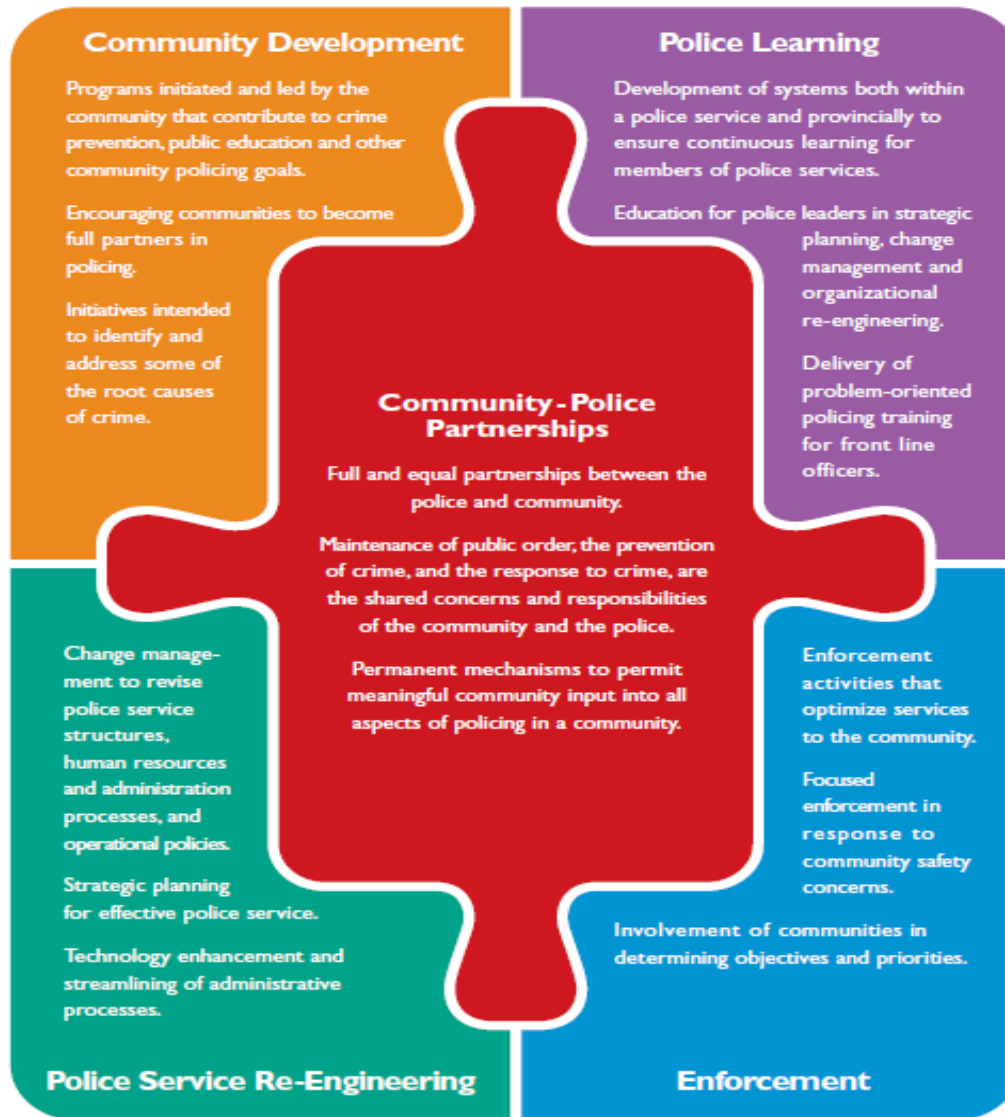

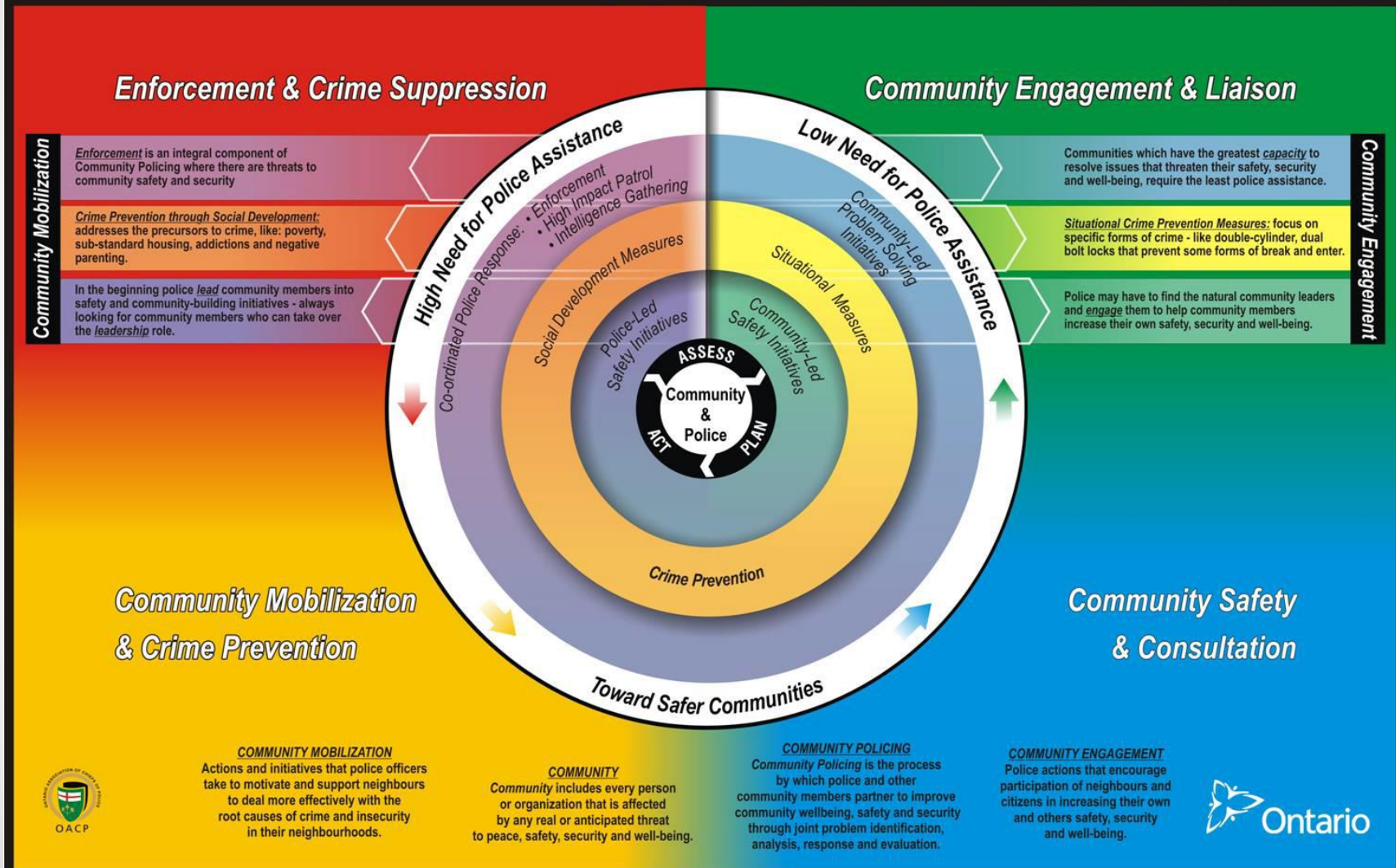

Ontario's Mobilization & Engagement Model of Community Policing

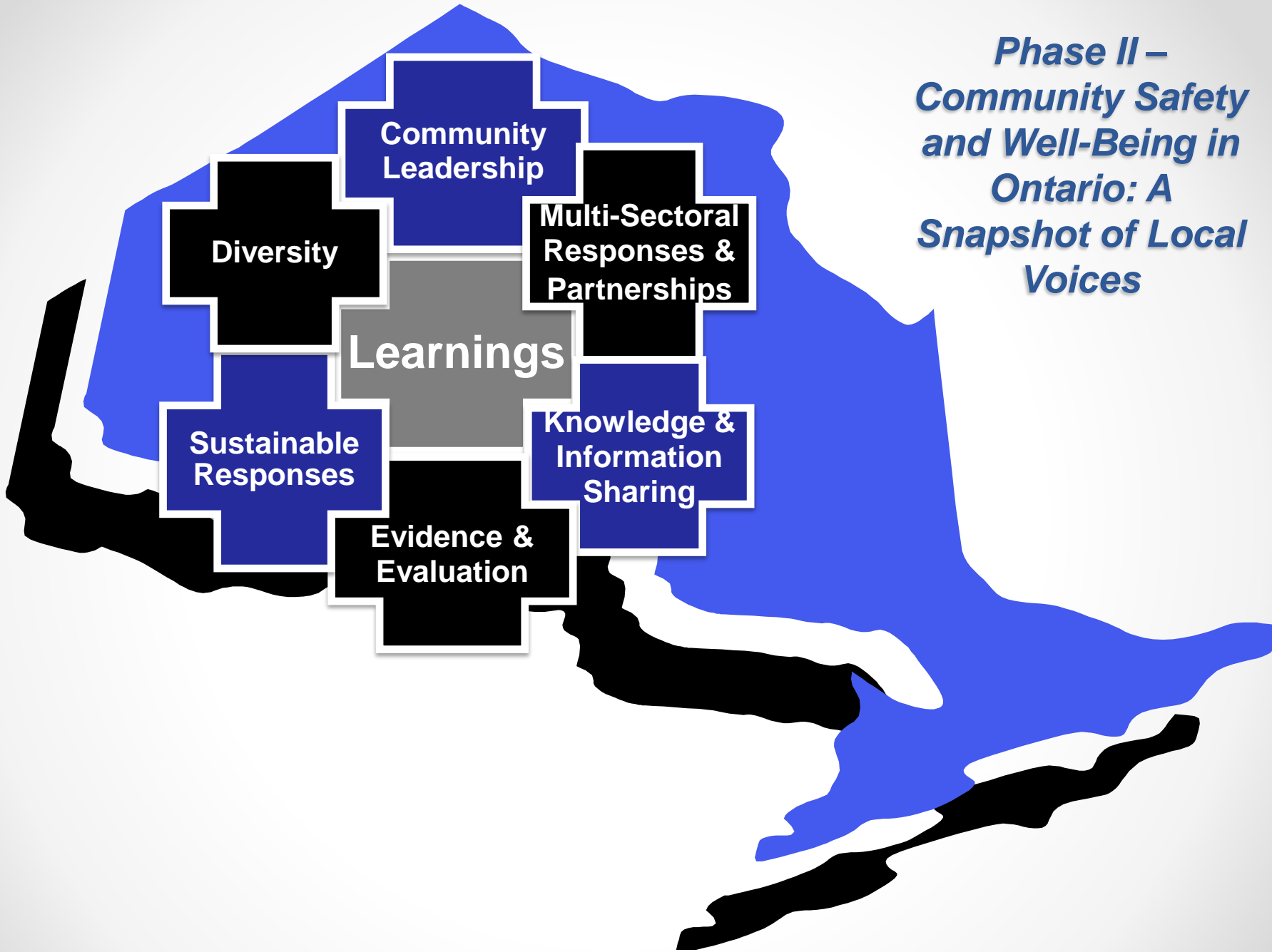


Provincial Approach to Community Safety and Well-Being

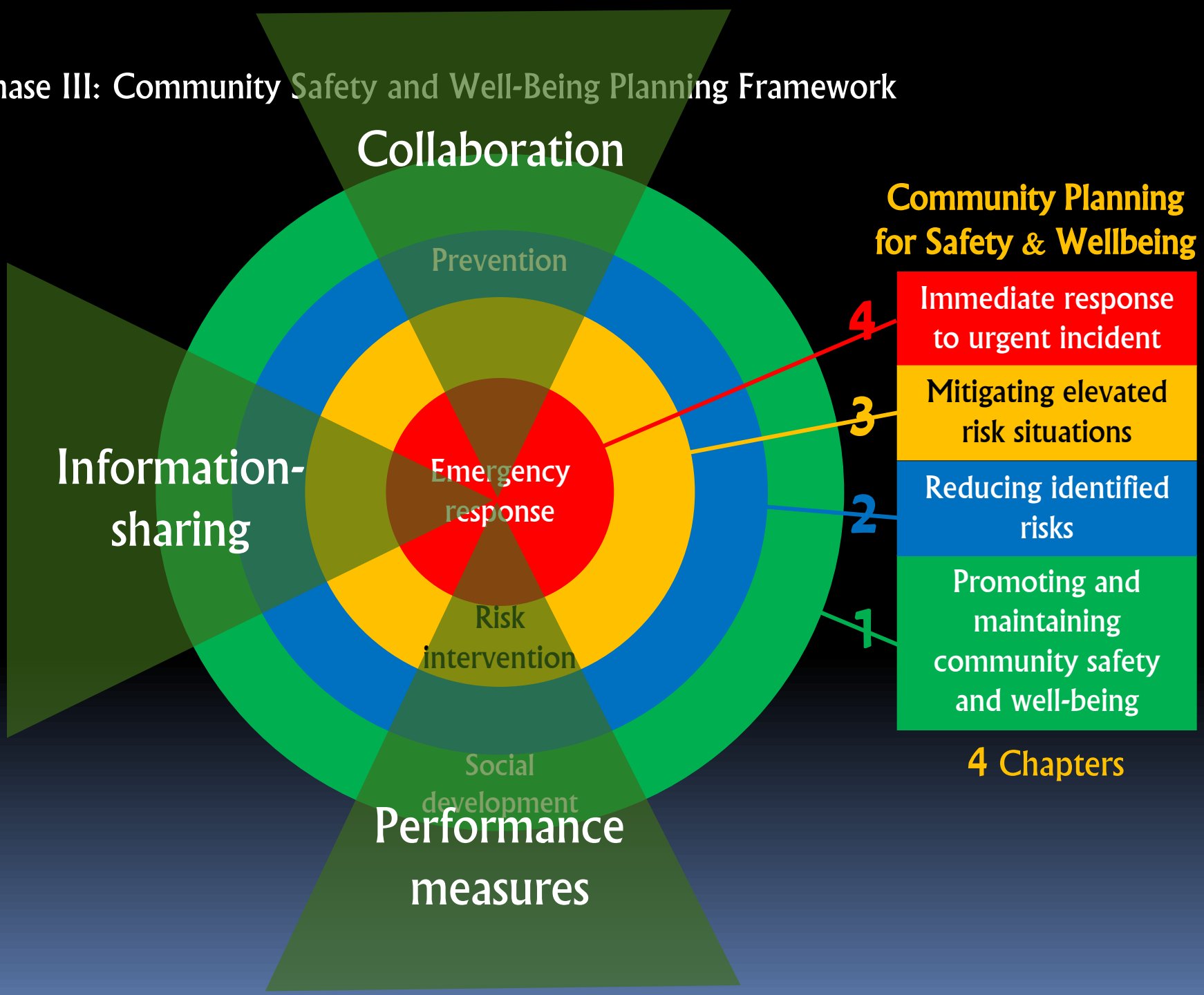
