

WHO CAN HELP PREVENT THESE CRIMES?

LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES

- Enforce stricter measures locally, and at borders.
- Conduct timely response, and investigations.

COURTS

- Timely prosecute, and convict human traffickers and migrant smugglers.
- Provide legal remedies to victims of human trafficking and migrant smuggling.

LOCAL MEDIA

- Raise public awareness.
- Promote ethical reporting standards.

TRAVEL, IMMIGRATION, AND EDUCATION AGENTS

- Guide people on traveling, and migrating to other countries through safe and regular channels.

PARENTS, TEACHERS, AND RELIGIOUS SCHOLARS

- Raise awareness in their communities.
- Highlight risks and dangers of human trafficking and migrant smuggling.

LOCAL/INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS, AND CIVIL SOCIETY

- Raise awareness.
- Advocate for improvements in policies, and programs.
- Provide essential, and social reintegration support services to victims of human trafficking and migrant smuggling.

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS

- Such as Social Welfare, Child Protection, Labour, and Women Development departments should provide essential, and social reintegration support to victims of human trafficking and migrant smuggling.
- Implement policies, and programs aimed at preventing, and addressing human trafficking and migrant smuggling.

LOCAL COMMUNITIES

- Actively engage in local neighborhoods, and look out for vulnerable individuals.
- Report human trafficking and migrant smuggling threats to concerned authorities.
- Youth can play an important role in spreading awareness in schools, universities, and communities.

AT RISK GROUPS

- Anyone can be a victim of human trafficking.
- Some people are more vulnerable than others. These include; women, children, transgenders, unhoused youth, and refugees or migrant workers.



HUMAN TRAFFICKERS

- Human traffickers operate as individuals, or as organized criminal groups.
- They make huge profits, and endanger lives.



EXPLOITATION OF VICTIMS

- Victims of trafficking, including children, are forced into begging.
- Women and girls are forced or tricked into sex trade, and domestic work.
- Victims receive little to no pay, and live under inhumane conditions.



LOCAL LAW

- Human trafficking is a serious, and punishable crime under the “Prevention of Trafficking in Persons Act, 2018”.

MIGRANT SMUGGLING

Irregular Transportation of Individuals to Other Countries



DUNKI

- Dunki is a local term for the practice of migrant smuggling.
- For e.g. small boats (dinghies) are often used by smugglers.



AT RISK GROUPS

- Migrant smuggling is life-threatening for all genders, and age groups, especially **Youth!**
- Migrant smuggling happens by **sea, land, and air.**



MIGRANT SMUGGLERS

- Migrant smugglers operate as individuals, or as organized criminal groups.
- They can disguise as a travel agent or post fake ads on social media (WhatsApp, Facebook, Dark Web) which constitutes ‘Cybercrime’.



EXPLOITATION OF VICTIMS

- Smuggled migrants are transported to other countries in dangerous environments such as in containers, and unsafe boats.
- During the journey, smuggled migrants often face physical torture and abuse by smugglers.
- **Remember!** Migrant smugglers make **false promises** and **forged documents** to take people to another country.
- Many precious lives have been lost.
